

PETITION TO THE SALT SPRING LOCAL TRUST COMMITTEE

WRITE A LETTER OF NON-CONCURRENCE TO ISED FOR THE PROPOSED ROGERS CHANNEL RIDGE TOWER AND REQUIRE THAT NO COMMERCIAL ANTENNAS BE PERMITTED ON ANY TOWERS BUILT BY CREST ON SALT SPRING

We, the undersigned, citizens of Canada draw the attention of the Salt Spring Local Trust Committee to the following:

THAT, WHEREAS, Rogers is proposing to build a 131-foot 4G and 5G commercial cellular tower in Channel Ridge with CREST, the CRD-funded Emergency Program, renting approximately 5% of this tower for emergency services;

WHEREAS, the proposed site is in close proximity to homes, a nature reserve, a popular recreational area and one of the island's most vulnerable watersheds;

WHEREAS, this project poses a liability risk to the Trust due to fire, data breaches, and health and environmental claims related to electromagnetic harm;

WHEREAS, this tower will not improve mobile access to 911, and Rogers' coverage maps show no need for another Rogers' cell site on the island,

THEREFORE, we the undersigned **RESIDENTS OF CANADA** call upon the Salt Spring Local Trust Committee to write a letter of non-concurrence to ISED for the proposed Rogers Channel Ridge tower, and to require that no commercial antennas be permitted on any towers built by CREST on Salt Spring Island.
